- 3) The Airplane Flight Manual Supplement as listed in Section I of Landmark Aviation Master Data List, Doc. No. 1012947, Revision A, dated April 06, 2007, or later FAA approved revision, is required on board the modified aircraft.
- 4) Instructions for Initial and Continued Airworthiness, Landmark Aviation Doc. No. 50-8008-004, Revision M, dated April 10, 2007, or later FAA approved revision, or Instructions for Initial and Continued Airworthiness, Garrett Aviation Services Doc. No. 52-8008-004, Revision B, dated February 15, 2005, or later FAA accepted revision, should be incorporated into the aircraft maintenance program.
- 5) If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or expiration date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
